MOMENTUM >US


Momentum is a measurable entity. It is the speed or force at which an object is moving. It can decrease, increase or stay the same. The word from the Lord, for our church in 2018 is that we would experience greater Momentum this year, we would pick up speed and have an increase in force.

What an awesome promise!

The momentum of an object is connected to many elements. For example, the momentum of riding a bicycle is directly related to the tires, gearing, the strength of the rider and the external conditions like the steepness of the road.
